- 2. Срок реализации проекта 12 месяцев
- **3. Организация-заявитель, предлагающая проект**: ГУО «Социальнопедагогический центр Советского района г. Минска» (далее – СПЦ)
- 4. Цель необходимой проекта: повышение качества оказания психологической помощи несовершеннолетним, подвергшихся насилию, создание оптимальных условий для беседы с ребенком ставшим жертвой действий либо свидетелем преступления, насильственных обстановки, сохраняющей психику ребенка при достоверном и откровенном рассказе о пережитом.
- СПЦ В августа 2012 функционирует года Комната несовершеннолетних, подвергшихся либо являющихся свидетелями насилия, опрошено более 230 несовершеннолетних детей, пострадавших от насилия, в том числе сексуального. Длительный период эксплуатации технического обеспечение, оборудования, устаревшее программное современного компьютерного диагностического материала предполагает принятие мер по обновлению материально-технической базы дружественной детям комнаты опроса и реабилитации.
- 5. Задачи, планируемые к выполнению в рамках реализации проекта: создать дружественные ребенку условия для участия в опросе; сократить числа опросов, в которых ребенок должен участвовать; создать условия для оказания психологической помощи и реабилитации ребенка и его семьи;

создать условия для тесного взаимодействия между службами по оказанию помощи несовершеннолетним, подвергшимся насилию.

6. Целевая группа

Несовершеннолетние, подвергшиеся различным видам насилия либо ставшие свидетелем преступлений, связанных с насильственными действиями. Опрос и допрос детей, ставших жертвами и свидетелями насильственных действий, - это повторная психологическая травма, поскольку ребенку приходится заново вспоминать и воспроизводить пережитое. НО риска повторной травматизации МОЖНО избежать, если опрашивать ребенка в ДРУЖЕСТВЕННЫХ ДЕТЯМ УСЛОВИЯХ, а именно когда ребенок чувствует

безопасность и уважение.

Крайне важно создать пространство, в котором ребенок мог бы раскрыть информацию, связанную с фактом насилия.

В СПЦ Советского района стабильно работает 2 специалиста (педагогипсихологи), прошедшие специальную подготовку, с 2012 года, накопившие опыт в проведении данных опросов, что вызывает большой спрос следственных органов в целом в Республике Беларусь. Специалисты СПЦ по данному направлению тесно сотрудничают и взаимодействуют с Главным управлением по наркоконтролю и противодействию торговле людьми криминальной милиции МВД Республики Беларусь, представителями которого расследуются уголовные дела с большим количеством потерпевших лиц. Необходимо отметить, что на базе СПЦ Советского района проводятся опросы несовершеннолетних детей из разных районов города Минска и из разных областей Республики Беларусь.

7. Краткое описание мероприятий в рамках проекта

Для реализации данного проекта необходимо:

текущий ремонт помещения;

приобретение специфического инвентаря (анатомические куклы, наушники, игрушки, методические пособия);

обновление техники (компьютер, 2 камеры) для фиксации процедуры опроса;

печать методических материалов по профилактике насилия над детьми; приобретение DVD-дисков для записи опросов;

приобретение комплекта компьютерной психодиагностики и других материалов и пособий для оказания помощи семье и ребенку в рамках последующей психологической реабилитации;

приобретение кресел – 2 единицы.

"Helping Without Harming"

(upgrading a child-friendly interview and rehabilitation room)

- **1.** The name of the project is "Helping Without Hurting" (upgrading a child-friendly interview and rehabilitation room)
- **2. The term of project implementation** 12 months
- **3.** The applicant organization that proposes the project is the State Educational Institution "Social and Pedagogical Center of the Soviet District of Minsk". (hereinafter SPC)
- **4. Aim of the project:** improving the quality of psychological assistance to minors subjected to violence, creating optimal conditions for talking to a child who is a victim of violence or a witness of a crime, an environment that preserves the child's psyche while giving a true and frank account of the experience.

Since August 2012 the interview room of minors who suffered from violence or witnessed violence has been functioning in the ECC, more than 230 minors who suffered from violence, including sexual violence, have been interviewed. The long period of operation of the technical equipment, outdated software, lack of modern computer diagnostic material require taking measures to update the material and technical base of the child-friendly interview and rehabilitation room.

5. Tasks planned to be carried out as part of the project:

create a child-friendly environment for participation in the survey;

to reduce the number of surveys in which the child must participate;

to create conditions for psychological aid and rehabilitation of the child and his/her family;

to create conditions for close interaction between services for assistance to minors who have been subjected to violence.

6. Target group

Juveniles who have experienced or witnessed different types of violence or violent crimes. Interviewing and questioning child victims and witnesses of abuse is traumatic because the child has to recall and re-enact their experiences. BUT the risk of re-traumatization MAY be avoided if the child is interviewed in a child-Friendly environment, that is, when the child feels safe and respected.

It is critical to create a space in which a child can disclose information related

to the fact of abuse.

There are 2 specialists (pedagogical psychologists) who have received special training since 2012 and have accumulated experience in conducting these interviews, which is in high demand by investigative agencies in the Republic of Belarus as a whole. Specialists of the SPC in this area closely cooperate and interact with the Main Department for Drug Control and Combating Human Trafficking of the Criminal Police of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Belarus, whose representatives investigate criminal cases with a large number of victims. It should be noted that underage children from various districts of the city of Minsk and from various regions of the Republic of Belarus are interviewed at the Sovetsky District Juvenile Justice Center.

7. A brief description of the project activities

In order to implement this project, it is necessary:

current repairs of the premises;

purchase of specific equipment (anatomical dolls, headphones, toys, teaching aids);

updating equipment (computer, 2 cameras) for recording the interview procedure;

printing of methodological materials on the prevention of child abuse; acquisition of DVDs for recording interviews;

acquiring a set of computerized psychodiagnostics and other materials and aids to assist the family and the child as part of the subsequent psychological rehabilitation; purchase of armchairs - 2 units.

- 1. Name of the project "Our Home"
- 2. The project implementation period is 2021-2022.
- **3. The applicant organization proposing the project is** the Department of Education of the Administration of the Partizansky District of Minsk, State Educational Institution "Social-Pedagogical Center of the Partizansky District of Minsk"

4. The goal of the project is-

- -distract teenagers from destructive habits;
- engage teenagers in active citizenship projects;
- develop communicative skills;
- organize leisure activities for adolescents and youth;
- promote mentally and physically healthy young generation, that is capable of having a family in order to maintain nation capacity;
- involve teenagers in volunteer work for the purpose of creation a barrier-free interaction between young people and people with disabilities

5. Tasks planned for implementation in the framework of the project:

Thus under the project entitled "Our home" for teenagers of Partizansky district a communication room has been established. But it still needs to be equipped renovation like acquisition of furniture, creating conditions for a "barrier-free" environment for children and adolescents with disabilities.

It's planned initially to create an appropriate place for children to protect them from socially disadvantaged environment.

In this room minors could speak not only with psychologists, but with their peers with similar interests and problems, and simply drink tea, watch films or play games.

All this will make it possible to find people who are close in spirit, friends, to feel like a necessary and significant member of society. We can organize and conduct various socially-oriented actions and events under the control of adults, involve their peers, get advice on career counseling, and navigate the modern labor market. The work of the competent authorities should be aimed at creating an environment without barriers for children with disabilities. From the point of view of the problem of disability, a barrier-free environment is such elements of the environment that they can freely enter and which can be used by people with physical, sensory or intellectual disabilities. The involvement of people with disabilities in society is the primary task of the state.

Along with providing assistance to those in need, an important aspect of the project is attracting the attention of teens to such moral concepts as kindness, responsiveness, sensitivity, hard work as well as creative development and self-realization of the younger generation.

6. Target group -

Juveniles and youth of Partizansky district, their legal representatives (biological parents, guardians, adoptive parents).

The population of the Partizansky district of the city of Minsk is 97.8 thousand people, 30.0 thousand are children and youth.

Partizansky district is a large industrial center of the capital, which has 142 industrial enterprises, including 21 large enterprises. This means that in the district there are many hostels where there are no proper conditions for organizing modern leisure for teenagers and youth.

As well as the low level of spiritual and moral culture of most modern parents, the incompetence of the family in matters of the spiritual formation and upbringing of the child, the loss of the family function of transmitting significant cultural and life values for young people, they lead to the destruction and crisis of the family.

As a result, it is necessary to educate both parents and youth in matters of spiritual and moral development. Therefore, it is necessary to create a psychological unloading room for legal representatives and a room so that adolescents themselves want to come there and spend their free time for their own benefit, rather than prefer to spend time in dubious companies on the street, endangering their lives and provoking themselves to commit offenses, and sometimes crimes.

The social sphere of the district is represented by 62 educational institutions. You can find 3 higher educational institutions among them and 10 institutions of

secondary special or vocational education there. These are nonresident youth who live in dormitories which were built in 50-80 years, where is no modern conditions for having an interesting time after studies.

After studing the minors' interests of Partizanskij area, analyzing the needs of today's youth and relying on the experience of Germany (the system of mobile work with young people in Stuttgard), the experts of SPC think that the creation of modern building in the frame of the project "Our home" will lendyou to distract young people and teenagers from harmful habits, to increase responsibility for their behavior and their life, to form mentally and physically healthy generation of young peoplewho are ready for independent life and create family, thus solving the problem of preserving health and potential of the nation, and form an active civilposition, in which there is some place for empathy and compassion for peers with disabilities opportunities.

7. Brief description of project activities

To implement this project, it is necessary to create favorable conditions in the center itself, so that children, adolescents and their parents would like to come and spend time in the classroom and would be interested in receiving qualified help.

At first it's necessary to equip the room for the minors (the 1st floor, room 6). The room needs to be repaired. It must be divided into several zones and include information field (WiFi, 3 notebooks, stereosystem, a big TV set on the wall with the internet, sports equipment (a jungle gym for teenagers, mats, apunching bag and boxing gloves, clay pigeons and magnetic darts or Velcro balls, a basketball hoop and a ball, board games), modern intellectual games for teenagers and the youth and appropriate furniture.





Near the room it's wise to place the kitchen where teenagers can microwave their food and drink tea (equipment: the basic set of kitchen furniture, an electric kettle, microwaves, cutlery (cups, plates, teaspoons). Also it's necessary to think about shower equipment in the bathroom. It requires to establish baffle walls and a shower room appropriately.

Moreover, it's necessary to repair the room for psychologists (room 1) to create required working conditions: (the room for psychological help, a sensor room for

psychological rest).





Fix ramps must be obligatory established for people with disabilities.
